Reliability Excellence for Managers Training

Course outline, makeup, timing, costs

- Combines instruction with a variety of hands-on and participative teaching methods
- Series is comprised of 2 segments 3-4 months apart
- Each segment will contain 2 consecutive 3 day workshops, one each week
- Between each segment, the participant will be asked to put into practice the knowledge provided in the preceding workshop

- Next segment TBA, however typically 3-4 months after the first
